

Byrd Bath – Provisions removed

- Changes to Federal Employees Retirement System contributions
- State authorization to conduct border security and immigration enforcement
- Limitation of court contempt powers to restrain preliminary injunctions and temporary restraining orders
- Barring noncitizens and permanent residents from receiving SNAP
- Extension of the suspension of permanent price authority
- Funding cap on the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau
- Authorization of the sale of millions of acres of public land
- Easing offshore oil and gas project compliance
- Requiring USPS to sell their electric vehicles
- Repealing an EPA rule limiting air pollution from passenger vehicles
- Permitting project developers to bypass judicial environmental reviews
- Increasing congressional power over more impactful regulations
- Medicaid:
 - Limiting states' use of provider taxes in financing their portions of Medicaid
 - Limiting noncitizen participation in Medicaid by lowering federal Medicaid funding for expansion states covering noncitizens using state funds
 - Repealing funding for gender affirming care under Medicaid
 - **Under consideration:** Prohibiting Medicaid payments to Planned Parenthood
